The top end is lovely for fly fishing but you must be very careful the Wyandotte ひらり wading is deep and dangerous. The gap opposite the Edradour Burn is a good cast. The tail of the pool as it glides into Pol Dour is another favourite place. Pol Dour – A holding pool that contains decent numbers of fish at times. Spruce Tree It is probably the best high water pool on the river. Fishes well right from the top to the bottom, opposite the fishing hut and the tail are the most Pol Traigh prolific sections. Brennans Corner - Low water pool for salmon and grilse but it requires a wade from the right bank to reach the gravel island. In low water con-Lower limit as ditions this is an easy wade but it should not be attempted when the water is higher and it must never be approached wading from upstream posted on left bank because there is a dangerous trough in the river bed. Either wade and at the fence on straight out to the island or upstream to ensure that you can always the right bank retreat in safety. Tom-Dachoille Cottage Middle Pool – Above the road bridge fishes well from the right bank and below the bridge it fishes best from the left bank. A lovely fly fishing pool that is worth a cast at any water height.

Spruce Tree – Two small pots that often contain a fish or two. The upper pot beneath the spruce tree is deep and fast, it fishes best in a low water, the lower pot is better with a foot or so on the gauge.

Wyndotte – Best fished by wading from the left bank to a gravel bar in

mid river. Extreme caution there are deep troughs in the gravel. It holds

fish even at the lowest river levels.

Pol Triech – A famous pool that is best fished by wading from the right bank. There is a deep trench close to the bank so take extreme care and do not wade too far downstream.
